Resources: Swimming pool timetable.

Questions/instructions:

This is a swimming pool timetable. It tells the times for each day when people can use the pool. You will see that there are timetables for the Main pool, the Learners pool, and the Water slide.

Point to the 3 sections on the timetable.

You will also see that there are special times for different kinds of sessions, like *Public sessions* and *School sessions*, and *Lesson times*.

Point to these on the timetable.

I want you to use this timetable to answer some questions.

1. If your school was going to use the Main pool during a *School session*, what time could it start an afternoon session?

Ask the student to point to the time given.

2pm 54(56)

2. If you wanted to go to the Main pool during a *Public session*, on Saturday, what is the earliest time in the day that you could go swimming?

Ask the student to point to the time given.

7am 66(72)

3. If you were swimming in the *Learners pool* during a *Public session* on Friday night, what time would the session finish?

Ask the student to point to the time given.

9:30pm 71(69)
