

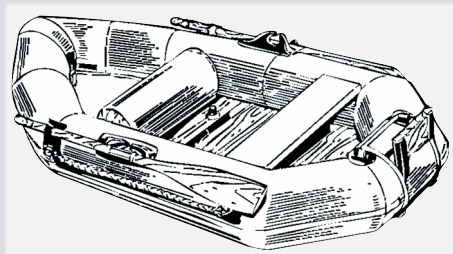
Gone Fishing
