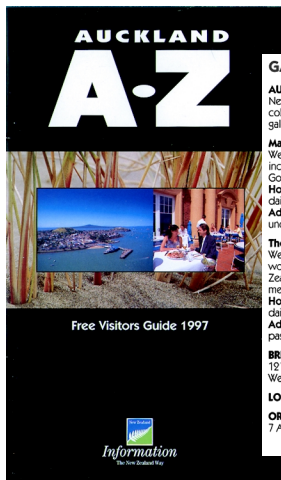

AUCKLAND ART GALLERY Infoline 09-309 0831
New Zealand's first permanent art gallery, opened in 1888. The country's most significant collections of New Zealand and European art, over 10,000 works, are housed in the gallery's two buildings.

Main Building
Wellesley at Kitchener St, Auckland. Focus here is on historical works. Collection displays include early New Zealand landscapes, portraits of the Maori by Charles Goldie and Gotfried Lindauer. Gallery cafe with outdoor terrace and Bookshop.
Hours: Open 10am-5pm daily except Christmas Day and Good Friday. Free guided tours daily at 9pm.
Admission: Collection displays free, temporary exhibition charge applies, children 12 & under free.

The New Gallery
Wellesley at Lorne St, Auckland. Focus on contemporary New Zealand art, new ideas, new works and new artists. Includes the McCahon room with changing displays of New Zealand's respected artist Colin McCahon. Gallery cafe and bar and a range of gallery merchandise.
Hours: Open 10am-5pm daily except Christmas Day and Good Friday. Free guided tours daily at 1pm.
Admission: \$3.00 adult, \$1.00 concession, children 12 & under free. Special tourist 1 day pass to both galleries \$7.00.
