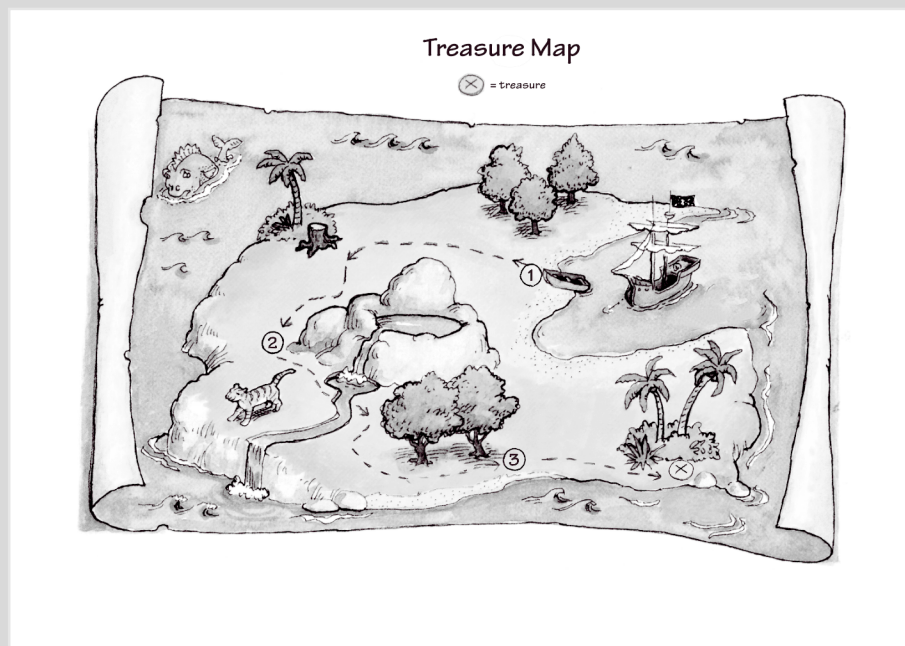


Treasure Island

Approach: Station

Resources: Treasure map.



Questions/instructions

Here is a map that Pirate Pete used to find the treasure. He stopped for a rest at three places. He looks to the front and can see to the sides when he stops, but he never looks back.

Draw a ring around what he can see at each stop.

Commentary

Students had considerable success interpreting the map and envisaging what they would see at each stop. About 70 percent of the students identified most of the correct choices and very few of the incorrect ones.
