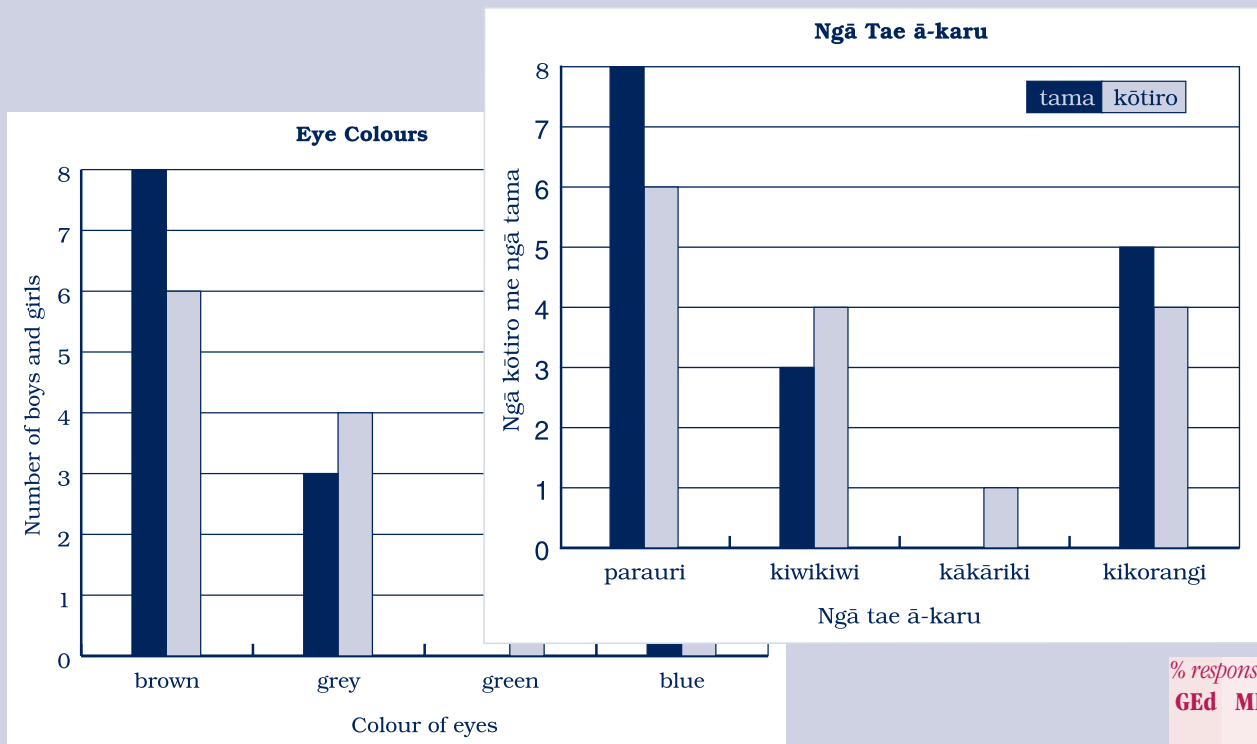


Ngā Tae ā-Karu — Eye Colours

Approach: Station

Focus: Converting a double bar graph into a table.

Resources: Ruler, pencil.



Questions/instructions:

Look at the bar graph called **Eye Colours**. The bar graph shows the different eye colours of boys and girls in Room 3.

Make a table showing eye colours of boys and girls in Room 3.

Tirohia te kauwhata pou o **Ngā Tae ā-Karu**.
