## Approach: One to one

Level: Year 4 and year 8
Focus: Relating money transactions to a graph of them.
Resources: Graph, ruler (to align graph bars with axis markings).
Questions/instructions:
Put graph and ruler in front of student.
This graph shows someone's bank account.

## Point to the word dollars.

Up this side is the amount of money the person has.

## Point to the word time.

Along the bottom are the days of a week.
Have a careful look at the graph then tell me a story to explain what is happening with the money.

Point to the beginning of the graph.
