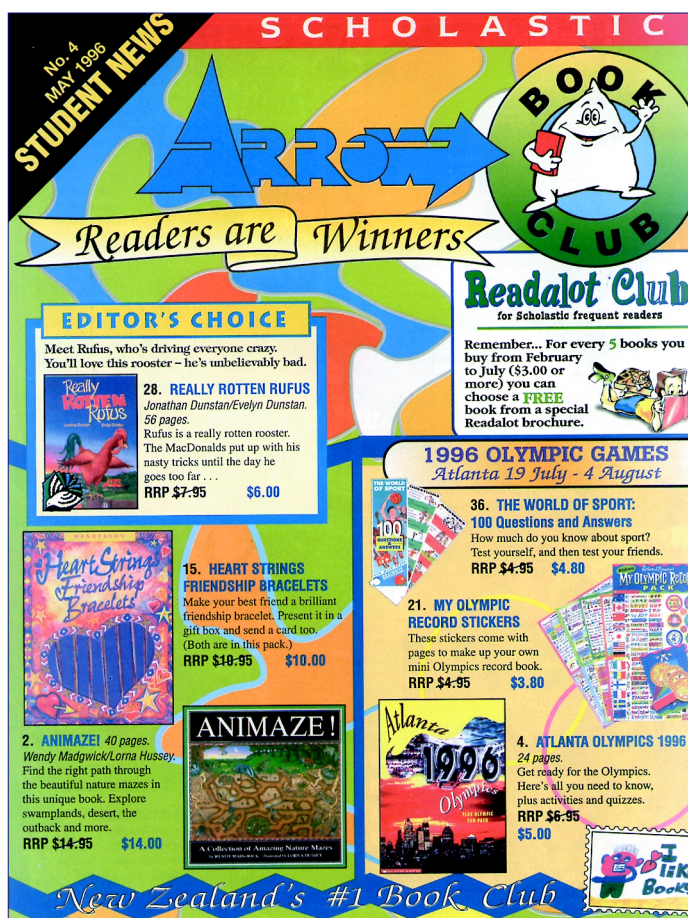


Book club news

Commentary

Both this task and the similar year 8 version *Book brochure* (opposite) produced similar results, despite different resource materials and questions.
