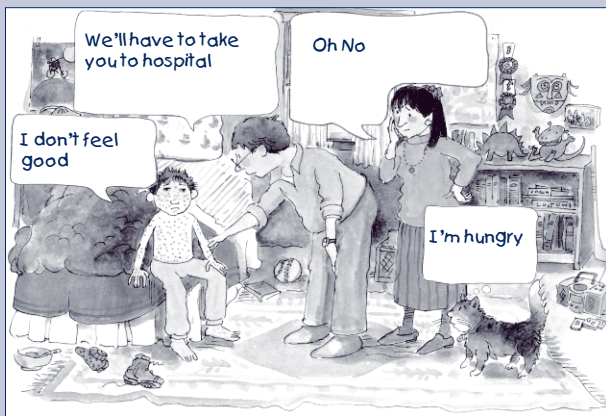
Commentary:
